Today Jesus tells us a story about a boy who decides he wants to leave his family to go have fun. When he runs out of money he decides to go home and ask for forgiveness for leaving. Jesus is using the story to teach us that God will ALWAYS love us and we should never be afraid to ask for forgiveness. We are not perfect. From time to time we will make choices and do things that are not very good. No matter what we do, though, God will love us and forgive us if we ask. This is called unconditional love. It is a huge gift that we receive from God and others such as our parents. It helps us to know that we are good and lovable and deserve respect and love.
