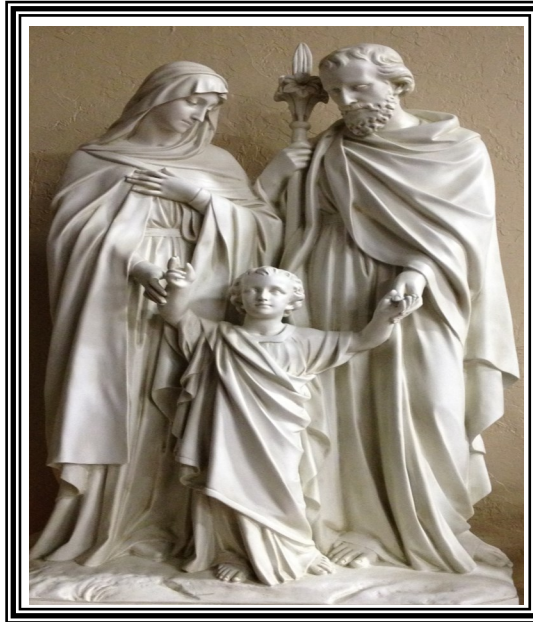

## **“Mensaje Pastoral del Parroco”**

Bendiciones Sagrada Familia. El Evangelio de hoy nos relata, “*Solo hay una cosa más la cual tienes que hacer*” . . . “*entonces tendrás un tesoro en el cielo. Después de esto, ven y sígueme.*” Con estas palabras, “*el hombre rico entristeció su cara y se fue*”. El evangelio dice que este hombre era muy rico, pero para nosotros es ir más allá de las riquezas. ¿Cuál es aquella cosa que tenemos que hacer por Dios, Iglesia o familia? Piense en “*esa cosa*” que le impide tener una mejor relación con Dios y los demás. ¿Qué es lo que estás haciendo al respecto? El llamado al discipulado es siempre retozo pero no imposible. Alguien dijo un día, “*Todos somos llamados a ser fieles no exitosos*” (Madre Teresa). Pregúntese así a su persona: ¿Acaso soy un fiel y verdadero discípulo de Cristo? ¿Cómo lo demuestro? ¿Cómo soy un discípulo del Señor? ¿Qué estoy haciendo de mi vida personal? ¿Qué es lo que tengo que dejar a un lado para poder seguir a Jesús? ¿Qué es lo que estoy haciendo para ayudar a la Sagrada Familia? ¿Qué haré hoy por la Sagrada Familia? ¿Qué es lo que he hecho para mostrar la Presencia de Dios en mi vida? No olvidemos que la oración y la acción van juntas. Seamos discípulos de Cristo, “*pues para el hombre es imposible, pero no para Dios. Con Dios todas las cosas son posible.*” Tengo plena confianza que ustedes pueden hacer grandes cosas por la Sagrada Familia con la gracia y le poder de Dios Todopoderoso.
